Meeting the Challenge.

The ability to provide an environmentally friendly product is more important than ever before. While there are many benefits to "Green" design, it offers new challenges. Understanding the customer's needs has become more difficult due to the fact that "Green" can mean different things to different people. To some a "Green" design focuses on sustainability and efficient use of resources. To others, it may focus on indoor air quality and reduced emissions. Whatever the case, our approach to providing solutions that focus on the customer's needs does not change.

Meeting the Standards.

There are several organizations working to develop guidelines and certifications to help consumers identify products that utilize environmental friendly materials and design. The Composite Panel Association's, EPP (Environmentally Preferred Products) is the first Third Party Certifier (TPC) approved by CARB (California Air Resource Board) in helping manufacturer's and fabricators of laminated composite panels meet California's Formaldehyde Air Toxic Control Measure Phase I and Phase II requirements.

Meeting your needs.

As a custom manufacturer, Corilam Fabricating works with all available products to meet the customer's needs. As a certified EPP Downstream Licensed Facility, we can provide products that meet the current CARB Regulations which are among the most recognized in the country.

Environmentally Responsible Design

The majority of our products are designed using recycled steel or wood based composite panels. These panels are produced from recycled wood that would otherwise occupy landfills. Particleboard, MDF and hardboard are manufactured using recycled and recovered wood fiber. These EPP (Environmentally Preferred Products) are certified with specific environmental characteristics such as 100% recycled wood content and low formaldehyde emissions, less than 0.18 ppm as required by CARB Phase I. No added formaldehyde products are also available.

We utilize Wilsonart® Laminates and adhesives which have been certified by the Greenguard Environmental Institute as low emitting products. These products do not contain urea-formaldehyde resins. In addition to the benefit of reduced emissions, using these materials may help qualify for LEED points such as MR Credit 4 - Recycled Content, MR Credit 5 - Regional Materials, or MR Credit 7 - Certified Wood. We responsibly utilize these materials in our product design in our efforts to produce environmentally friendly products.

Not only are we concerned of the environmental impacts of our products, but we are equally concerned that our production processes are environmentally responsible as well. Metals, cardboard packaging, plastic containers, and papers are recycled. We utilize water based adhesives for our laminating process and powder coated finishes for our finishing processes both of which are important parts of reducing VOC emissions.
